First, the reference page is always the last page in your essay. At the top of the page, place the word "References". Do not make it bold or underline it. All the text on this page should have the same spacing as the rest of your essay.

So how to cite a book in an essay according to MLA? Write the last name of the author followed by a comma and the first name followed by a period. Then put the essay name in quotations (the period must be inside the last one) and make the first letters of words capital. Write the title in italics (if you hand write, then just underline it).

The Chicago/Turabian style of citing sources is generally used when citing sources for humanities papers, and is best known for its requirement that writers place bibliographic citations at the bottom of a page or at the end of a paper.

In-text citations: Author-page style
MLA format follows the author-page method of in-text citation. This means that the author's last name and the page number (s) from which the quotation or paraphrase is taken must appear in the text, and a complete reference should appear on your Works Cited page.

To cite the entire anthology or collection, list by editor (s) followed by a comma and "editor" or, for multiple editors, "editors." This sort of entry is somewhat rare. If you are citing a particular piece within an anthology or collection (more common), see A Work in an Anthology, Reference, or Collection below.

In MLA format, you use the author's last name followed by the page numbers in parentheses after a sentence or group of sentences referring to the essay. For example, (Sedaris 25-32) -- without the quote marks -- would finish your sentence, and you place the sentence's period after the parenthetical citation.

To cite a critical essay published in the same volume as a literary work, follow the MLA format template. List the author of the essay, followed by the title. Then list the name of the volume from which you accessed the essay, followed by the the volume's publication details.

How do I cite an authored work contained in another authored work, like an essay in a textbook? To cite an essay with an author in a textbook with authors rather than editors, follow the MLA format template and list the authors of the textbook in the "Other contributors" slot:

Cite both authors' names in your essay every time you refer to their research if the work only has two authors. If a work has three to five authors, cite all the authors the first time you mention their research, but use "et al." after the first author name in subsequent citations.
